

## REGISTRATION OF CIVIL STATUS ACTS (BIRTH, MARRIAGE, DEATH, DIVORCE)

Required documents:

- ✓ Relevant original Act & its translation in Greek
- ✓ Power of attorney with a mandate to file the registry information (acts)

**Note!** *The name and Surname of the concerned individuals **must be the same in all the Acts** And it must be the same as the information which is already registered your Municipality in Greece. If there are inconsistencies, an identification certification must be issued.*

### **A. ACT OF DEATH**

*Information required for the registration at the Special Registrar's Office*

*Full name as it appears in the family lot in Greece*

*Required information of the deceased which are declared by signing a solemn declaration:*

TAX ID NO. (AFM)

SOCIAL INSURANCE NO. (AMKA)

PENSION IN GREECE (*IKA, OGA, etc. –If yes, record no.*)

### **B. ACT OF BIRTH**

*For children born before the registration of their mother or father in their Municipality in Greece,*

*An Act of determination of nationality is required ( x 2 certified copies of the Canadian Act of birth)*

**Note!** *The name and Surname of the parents must be the same as the information already registered in Greece*

### **C. ACT OF MARRIAGE**

*If one of the spouses does not have the Greek nationality, his/her Act of birth is required.*

*For the registration of a religious Orthodox marriage, a stamp fee must be paid and an order by the Public Prosecutor is required*

### **D. REGISTRATION OF ACT OF DIVORCE**

*To register your divorce, which was issued abroad, in Greece, a court judgment regarding the enforceability of the divorce in Greece is required.*

**DOCUMENTS FOR RECOGNITION & ENFORCEABILITY OF ACTS ISSUED ABROAD (DIVORCE, CHANGE OF NAME etc.)**

**A. Certified copy of the court judgment or the administrative act**

**B. Certificate of irrevocable divorce (namely, that the judgment is final and in effect).**

**C. A relevant Act of the judgment event (e.g. marriage, birth etc.)**
